- The video must be emailed to renata.porter@diabetesyouth.org.nz by 1st February 2012 in order to be shown at the conference.

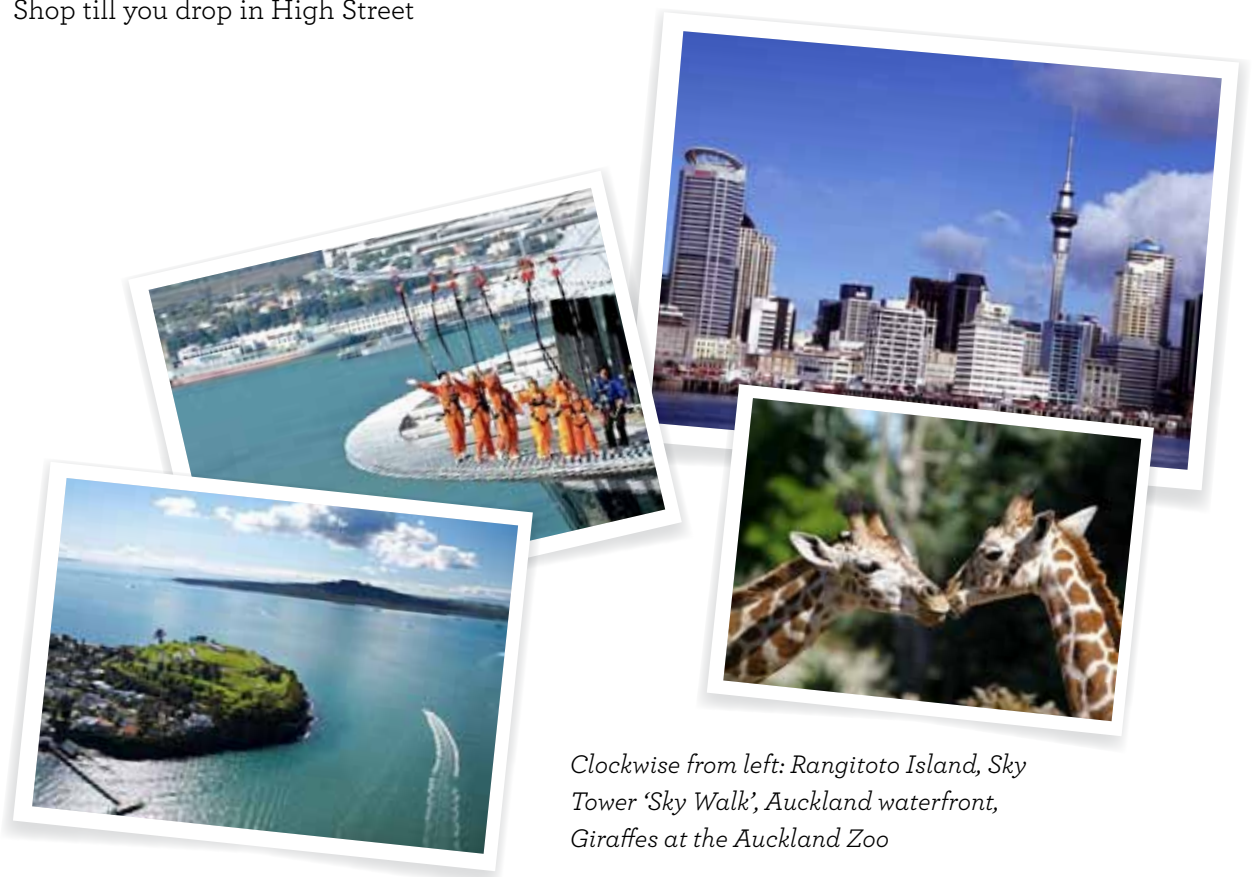


Things to see and do in Auckland
