## TEEN CAMP FUNDING APPLICATION

### Terms and Conditions

- Funding applications are limited to events for teens aged between 13 and 18 years. The events must have clearly defined learning outcomes that have relevance to the diabetes youth community.
- Funding is provided at a minimum of NZ\$2000 per organisation per event. Organisations wishing to combine resources to host a joint event should apply separately for funding.
- Applications are open from 1 July to 20 September, with final approvals determined by November and funds will be made available from end January of the following year.
- A detailed budget, including vendor quotes, must be submitted with the funding application.
- A detailed event expense report will be required within 30 days after the event to outline how the funding was applied.
- A post-event evaluation must be submitted detailing the event outcomes and key learnings.
- Diabetes Youth New Zealand reserves the right to decline applications where the event does not meet the funding criteria specified above.
- Diabetes Youth New Zealand reserves the right to withdraw funding or require reimbursement should funds be abused or applied to non-complying events.
